HON. GEORGE W. JONES, Democrat, of the Fayetteville (Tennessee) District, one of the oldest members of the House of Representatives, has been renominated to Congress by a District Convention of his party. The Democratic majority is very large, and Mr. JONES will probably have no organized opposition. Hon. **WILLIAM H. POLK**, brother of the late President, is spoken of as an independent candidate. The canvass for Governor in Tennessee waxes warm between Gov. **ANDREW JOHNSON** and Mr. **GENTRY**, Whig and American. The result to-morrow, in Virginia, will probably have an important influence in determining the Tennessee contest. The election is on the first Thursday in August.
