## Political.

Hon. GRORGE W. Jones, Democrat, of the Fayetteville (Tennessee) District, one of the oldest members of the House of Representatives, has been renominated to Congress by a District Convention of his party. The Democratic majority is very large, and Mr. Jones will probably have no organized opposition. Hon. WILLIAM H. POLK, brother of the late President, is spoken of as an independent candidate. The canvass for Governor in Tennessee waxes warm between Gov. Andrew JOHNSON and Mr. GENTRY, Whig and American. The result to-morrow, in Virginia, will probably have an important influence in determining the Tennessee contest. The election is on the first Thursday in August.
