

SWIFT JUSTICE.

Negro Ravisher in Tennessee Is
Hanged by a Mob.

Awful Murder of a Young Girl in
Florida - Men Suspected of the
Deed May Be Lynched.

NASHVILLE, Tenn., Sept. 7.—While Mr. Charles Jones, a highly respected citizen of Lincoln county, was in Fayetteville Monday night attending lodge a negro broke into his residence in the country, where his wife and her sister were staying, and committed a criminal assault on the wife. The sister ran away to secure aid. Both women recognized the negro as Dock King, a farm hand. King's arrest followed next day, and he was found to have marks on his arm that was injured while he was forcing his way into the house. Both women visited King in jail Thursday and further identified him as their assailant. Friday morning at an early hour a mob of 200 men took King from the jail and hanged him to a tree.
